Identify Counties that utilize a specific service or program:

In the upper right corner of the page there are two lists. One is a list of the available services and the second is a list of the available programs. Click on the service or program that you wish to see more information about. Once clicked the Description box will give a little more information pertaining to the selected service or program. The map will highlight all the counties that currently provide that service or program.

View available services and programs available for a county:

Select a county you wish to see the services and programs from by clicking on either the location of the county on the map, or the name of the county in the table. A popup will be displayed listing the services, providers and what programs are offered. Under each service, which is displayed with the name of the service in the row with a blue background, is a list of the organizations that provide this service. The name of the organization is displayed, and if available hyperlink to their website. For each organization that provides the service there is a checkmark under the program(s) if they provide them.

Go back to the main page:

After viewing the services and programs available for a county you may wish to go back to the main page. Clicking on the "x" in the upper right corner of the popup, the close button on the bottom right corner of the popup or anywhere on the screen that does not contain the popup will close the popup.
